Flash can be used to create Character, Effects and Text Animation for use on television, websites, and games or just to create fun moving cards for friends. The workshop covers;

- introduction to a growing industry
- the Flash interface
- Flash tools
- importing images into Flash
- drawing using Flash
- the Timeline, Library, Properties and Color Windows
- how to create and use Symbols effectively
- building Animation
- exporting Flash movies
- how to make money using Flash

*For participants on short courses*

### **FEES PAYMENT**

All course fees must be paid in full one week prior to the commencement of the course. (Please refer to "Payment Information" on the enrolment form for payment methods.)

All courses require a minimum number of participants to run. In the event of minimum course numbers not being reached, participants will be advised of transfer or refund options.

#### **Short Courses - up to & including 4wks duration**

Where the student withdraws from the course and notifies the school in writing 1 working day or more, prior to the course commencing, South Seas shall facilitate to the student, via the Trustee, a total refund of any fees paid, less an administration charge of \$50.00. Students withdrawing after this period will not be eligible for any refund.

#### **Short Courses - 5wks or more but less than 3 months**

Where the student withdraws from the course and notifies the school in writing 3 working days or more, prior to the course commencing, South Seas shall facilitate to the student, via the Trustee, a total refund of any fees paid, less an administration charge of \$50.00. Students withdrawing after this period will not be eligible for any refund.
