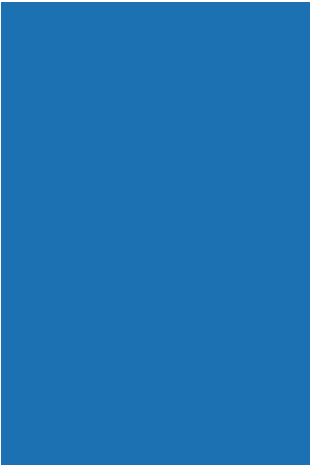
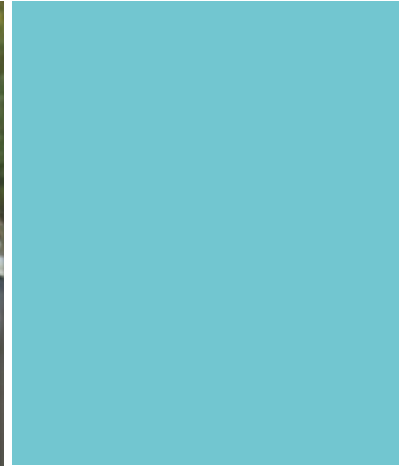

Course Content

Once you've tried your hand at everything, you will be able to major in one of the following aspects of film and television production:

Production: You love being in the middle of the action, with everyone depending on you. You revel in relationships, knowing what people do best and how to get it out of them – for the best possible creative outcome. You see the big picture. You see the global marketplace, the audience, the future.

Directing & Screenwriting: You are full of ideas. Your enthusiasm is contagious. You can imagine things that don't yet exist – they are as real as the chair you're sitting on. 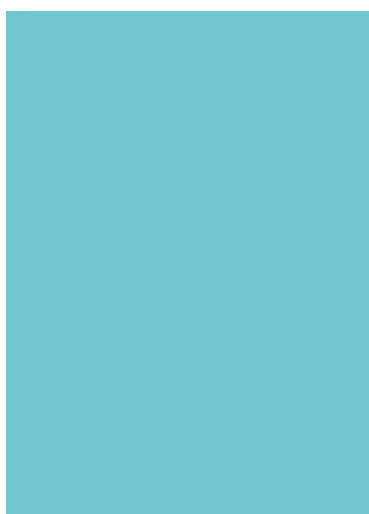
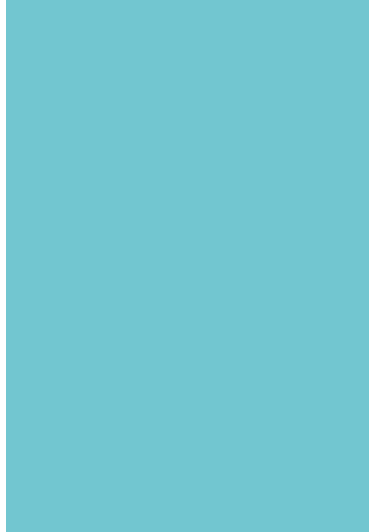
We aim for Screen Production graduates to be able to:
